Winner will perform as a soloist with The United States Air Force Band at a 2013 concert in the nation's capital.

### • WHO CAN ENTER?

The 2013 United States Air Force Band Young Artist Competition is open to high school woodwind instrumentalists in grades 9-12 who are **citizens or legal permanent residents of the United States**. The 2014 competition will be open to brass and percussion players.

<b>OBOE</b>	W. A. Mozart – <i>Oboe Quartet, K. 370, Mvt. I</i>
<b>CLARINET</b>	Carl Maria von Weber – <i>Concerto No. 2 in E-flat Major, Op. 74, Mvt. III</i>
<b>BASSOON</b>	W. A. Mozart – <i>Concerto in B-flat, K. 191, Mvt. I (with cadenza of choice)</i>
<b>ALTO SAXOPHONE</b>	Jacques Ibert – <i>Concertino, Mvt. II, Larghetto - Animato</i>

### APPLICATION INFORMATION

#### Preliminary Round Requirements:

1. Compact disc recording of applicant performing required selection in its entirety without cuts with accompaniment.
2. Typewritten letter with applicant's name, instrument, address with zip code, telephone number, school, grade, email address and statement (signed by a parent) agreeing to appear at the Washington, D.C. finals at the applicant's expense. Air travel and lodging (if required) will be provided to the winner and a chaperone for the winner's appearance with The United States Air Force Band.
3. Previous winners are ineligible.


